- Last Minute OPTIONAL SAT/ACT in the Fall:
 - ACT: Oct 26 (registration due Sept 20)

 - NOT required for CSU/UC

Spring 2024

- Ongoing: Complete Financial Aid Application
 - All students **MUST** do this or officially opt out. Also must complete FAFSA/CADAA to receive AUHSD Pledge benefits (**FREE** first year tuition at Cypress College or Fullerton College)
- Feb–Mar: Notified of CSU/UC admissions decisions
- Ongoing: Financial Aid Award “Letter” notification showing grant/loan opportunities (emailed to student personal email; not emailed to parents/guardians)
- Late Spring: Register for community college
 - For CSU/UC applicants: Consider waiting until after CSU/UC acceptance and financial aid award letter notifications
- May 2025: AP exams if taking an AP class
- Thursday, May 22, 2025: Graduation Day!

C- or higher in all A-G eligible courses &
A-G GPA Requirement (CSU: 2.5+ / UC: 3.0+)

CSU & UC Eligibility

Minimum requirements needed to be accepted to 4 year Universities.

Grade of C- or better

Students are encouraged to take courses beyond the minimum requirements as all campuses are impacted and admissions is competitive.

Minimum A-G GPA @ CSU= 2.5

Minimum A-G GPA @ UC= 3.0

Minimum 3.0 GPA

Low and Middle Income Families



Cal Grant B

Minimum 2.0 GPA

Disadvantaged and Low Income Families



Cal Grant C

Award money for students enrolling in a vocational program for a minimum of 4 months.

Minimum high school GPAs:

Cal Grant A: 3.0 GPA

Cal Grant B: 2.0 GPA



Cal Grants/Awards

- **Cal Grant A Awards** - up to \$12,630 at a U.C., \$5,742 at a CSU, and \$9,084 at an independent or private college. If attending a Community College, award will be held in reserve for up to 3 years until you transfer to a four-year college. Entitlement and competitive grants available.
- **Cal Grant B Awards** - for students with a GPA of at least 2.0, who come from disadvantaged or low income families, additional living allowance of \$1,672 and up to the same award amounts of Cal Grant A for the second year. Entitlement and competitive grants available.
- **Cal Grant C Awards** - for students from low income families pursuing vocational programs of study. Awards up to \$1,094 for books, tools, etc. and up to \$2,462 for tuition and fees at a private college.
- **California Community College (CCC) Transfer Entitlement Grant** - CCC students who meet all the Cal Grant eligibility requirements, have at least a 2.4 community college GPA, and meet the awards additional requirements are guaranteed a Cal Grant to attend a four-year college.

- **APEX is an online program used to remediate courses for graduation or A-G (4 year college)**
- **DayPEX has begun**
- **After school APEX - orientation is next week; will be calling you out to give you enrollment forms**
- **4 year college applicants: Focus on completing apex classes by end of September/early October BEFORE CSU/UC apps are due end of November**

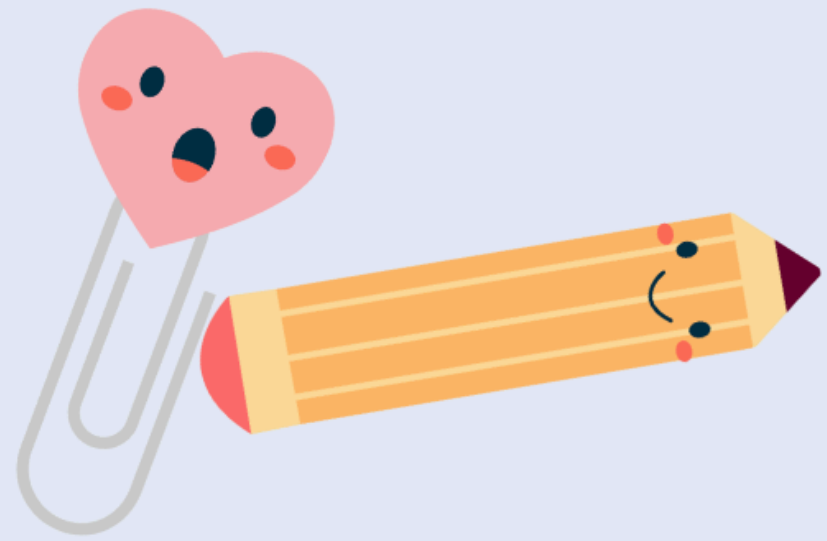
